

Ealing's G&T Network 2011 - 2012

Vision

In a time of limited resources it is intended that the Ealing G&T Network will enable schools to share expertise and collaborate on projects that can benefit learners from across the borough and across the phases. The G&T Network aims to build collegiality, and build capacity in lead G&T teachers.

Practice

The network meets termly and, with LA facilitation, collectively plans Ealing-wide competitions and events, and provide an opportunity for lead teachers to share resources with one another. The membership includes G&T Lead teachers from all Secondary Schools, and an LA facilitator.

In September 2011 the network will liaise with the new Primary G&T Network (run by Lead G&T teachers at primary) and share resources across phase as well as laterally.

Principles of working

G&T Network members are supported by a guidance document written by a working party of Primary and Secondary Lead teachers in 2010-11.

Related projects

The G&T network shares principles of working with the Outreach network, PLC and post-16 PLC, and LRP programmes.
