## Ealing's Young People's Sexual Health and Pregnancy Referral Pathway

Has the young person had unprotected sex?

**Yes**

If within 3 days/ 72hrs of unprotected sex, refer for Emergency Hormonal Contraception at:

- Pharmacies (see overleaf)
- Family Planning Clinics 0208 574 2481 (see overleaf)
- Ealing GUM 0208 967 5555

Refer young person (and partner if possible) for a sexual health and STI screening:
