### National child measurement programme (NCMP)

Every year, as part of the NCMP, children in reception (aged 4-5 years) and year 6 (aged 10-11 years) have their height and weight measured during the school year allow analysis of trends in growth patterns and obesity. Download on the [LA reports section](#).

### Health related behaviour survey (HRBS)

This half term marks the launch of the 2025 Health Related Behaviour Survey (HRBS)—a important survey that provides rich, anonymised insight into the health and wellbeing of pupils in Years 4, 6, 8 and 10. Fully funded and supported by Ealing Council, the HRBS is the only borough-wide dataset of its kind, spanning education, health, and social care. It helps schools and services understand the lived experiences of children and young people, enabling more targeted, evidence-based support.

The data feeds directly into Ealing's Joint Strategic Needs Assessment for children and young people. By linking datasets across teams, we can identify key trends—such as how health behaviours relate to attainment or social care needs—and shape more effective interventions.

### Why take part in the health related behaviour survey (HRBS)

- Receive a detailed, anonymised report of your pupils' responses, benchmarked against borough-wide data
- Strengthen your evidence base for evaluating interventions
- Inform your PSHE curriculum, safeguarding, and whole-school priorities
- Track trends and demonstrate the impact of your wellbeing initiatives.
