National child measurement programme (NCMP)

Every year, as part of the NCMP, children in reception (aged 4-5 years) and year 6 (aged 10-11 years) have their height and weight measured during the school year to inform local planning and delivery of services for children; and gather population-level surveillance data to allow analysis of trends in growth patterns and obesity.

The NCMP also helps to increase public and professional understanding of weight issues in children and is a useful vehicle for engaging with children and families about healthy lifestyles and weight issues. The graphs compare the weight of reception and year 6 pupils in Ealing schools and are available to download on the [LA reports section](#).

Health related behaviour survey (HRBS)

The 2019 Ealing HRBS took place in October 2019 and a total of 11,285 pupils took part from 12 high schools and 67 primary schools. Schools received their reports in November 2019 and these are available to download from your school page report section.
