

School Governance (Roles, Procedures and Allowances) (England) Regulations 2013

The School Governance (Roles, Procedures and Allowances) (England) Regulations 2013 were laid before parliament on Monday 8 July 2013 and will come into force in September 2013.

The new regulations replace three sets of existing regulations:

- The Procedures Regulations
- The Terms of Reference Regulations
- The Allowances Regulations.

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction
- Holding the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils
- Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.
