- Taking an active role in attendance improvement, support their school(s) to prioritise attendance, and work together with leaders to set whole school cultures.
- · Ensure school leaders fulfil expectations and statutory duties.
- Ensure school staff receive training on attendance.
- Regularly review attendance data and help school leaders focus support on the pupils who need it.
- · What should be in your school's attendance policy
- Sharing best practice
