Sypol COSHH risk assessment

Corporate health and safety launched the online COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health) risk assessment tool Sypol in October 2018. Six face to face training sessions have been delivered to assist staff with using the system. As of April 2019, Corporate Health and Safety will no longer provide face to face training on Sypol.

A comprehensive Sypol user guide* (pdf - *EGfL login required) has been created which guides users on how to use the tool.
