
Children missing education - new pupil registration requirements

In July 2016 the government published their response to the consultation on improving information in identifying children missing education. As a result, the regulations for reporting joiners and leavers changed as of 1 September 2016.

We have produced a [SIMS.net report](#) (zip) to collect this information from your MIS, although some information will need to be added manually.

All schools should run an initial report in order that we can collect information regarding your joiners and leavers from 1 September. Subsequent reports should be run for weeks in which you have had joiners/leavers and submitted by close of business on the following Monday.
