



PlayStreets for Schools - 3 April next deadline

Why not close the road around your school and reclaim the street for play? Now you can!

Schools can now apply to close the road outside their building for up to once a month and up to three hours at a time. PlayStreets are a great opportunity to harness enthusiasm from parents and the school communities and also present a real solution to the road danger and air quality problems experienced at many schools.

The application process, including resident consultation, takes up to 12 weeks in total (from beginning of application to first PlayStreet). The next deadline for consultations to be completed is the 3 April which gives you enough time to complete the consultation if you start soon.

Apply now in order to get your first PlayStreet up and running by May!
