The London Transport Museum's skilled facilitators will inspire your pupils with enquiry-based activities. The day begins with an interactive introduction followed by:

- Depot Exploration: Pupils will have the chance to interact with some of the unique wonders of our iconic collections and hear the story of how engineers have transformed London over time
- Q&A session with STEM Ambassadors (industry professionals)
- 'Sustainable Cities': Pupils will work together to design a net zero city and tackle contemporary challenges faced by engineers and urban planners

Through the workshop pupils will:

- Develop and demystify their understanding of what engineering is;
- Enhance their team-working, problem solving, and communication skills;
- Experience positive perceptions of careers in transport and engineering;
- Gain practical insight into careers in engineering at Transport for London (TfL) and other major UK organisations.
