- maximizing big events: Learn how to get the most from larger events like Walk to School Month and Car Free Day, which are instrumental in building
 momentum for sustainable travel efforts.
- submitting your application: Detailed support is available on how to complete and submit accreditation applications, helping your school achieve recognition for its efforts.
- drop-in troubleshooting sessions: TfL offers dedicated troubleshooting sessions to help with specific challenges, providing a flexible way for School Travel Champions to stay on track.
