

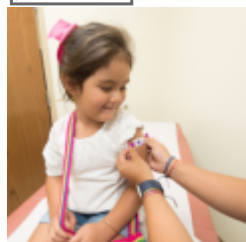
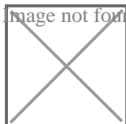

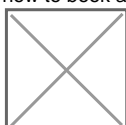

Catch up flu clinics are running for children and young people in reception to year 11 who may have missed their school vaccination. Details of clinics and how to book appointments. Please share with parents.



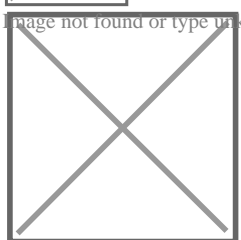
