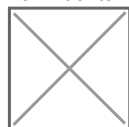

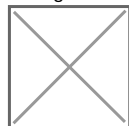
Reminder to report all Reception Year 7 starters who do not arrive as expected on Friday 26 September

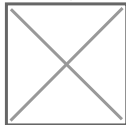




Artificial intelligence (AI) network for primary and special schools
