Universal 15 hours	£5.27

Deprivation (mandatory) only 3 and 4 year olds	5% of supplement funding £0.29
Quality	5% of supplement funding
Quality QTS	£0.29
2 year old (working parents)	£8.24
2 year old (disadvantaged)	£8.24
Deprivation (2 year old disadvantaged)	£0.91
Under 2 year old offer (working parents)	£11.92
