EPC Behaviour Management Programme

Target Audience: Teachers and Adults leading learning in the classroom

Number of Session: 5×2 hour sessions, held once a half term across an academic year. Although it would be possible for staff to only attend certain sessions, the programme is planned as a unit comprising of 6 parts

Venue: Ealing Primary Centre
