GovernorHub have offered a **FREE trial for all Ealing Schools until September** to support with the business of governance during Covid 19.

<u>GovernorHub</u> is an online tool that provides you with the tools to securely manage your governor membership details, calendar dates for meetings, upload, save and share governor documents/ meeting papers and creates easy ways for you to communicate with your board members/ with each other. They are also developing an integrated video meeting tool as part of the GovernorHub platform to run video conferencing meetings.
