Dear Parent/Carer

The Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI) guidance in relation to COVID-19 vaccinations for children and young people has been updated. See link below for further information.

The COVID-19 vaccination will now be offered to children and young people aged 12 years and over with specific underlying health conditions that put them at risk of serious COVID19. This includes children 12 to 15 years of age with severe neuro-disabilities, Down's syndrome, underlying conditions resulting in immunosuppression, and those with profound or severe learning disabilities (with or without cerebral palsy) or who are on the learning disability register. Children with autism who attend a special school or an additional resource provision (ARP) may also receive the vaccination.

The clinics are planned to be held on:

- Friday 27th August 2021, 10am - 3pm
- Wednesday 1st September 2021, 10am - 4pm
- Thursday 2nd September 2021, 10am - 4pm

**Please note the child/young person must be accompanied by an adult who has parental responsibility and is permitted to give consent at the clinic on the day (please note, other family members**

**will not suffice for this). Please do print out and fill in the consent form ahead of the appointment and bring it along with you.**

If you are unsure about giving your child the vaccination, you can attend the session on the day to ask further questions and then decide.

If you have any questions about the vaccine, please contact your child's paediatrician/GP or school nurse to discuss.

### **On the day**

Please make sure that your child is wearing practical clothing so that it's easy to access their upper arm. The healthcare professional who is vaccinating your child will ask you the following questions:

- Is your child currently unwell with a fever?
- Is your child waiting for a Covid test result or have they had Covid in the last 28 days?
- Has your child had any vaccinations in the last 7 days?
- Has your child ever had a serious allergic reaction needing adrenaline?
- Is your child taking a specific blood thinning medication (warfarin)?

### **Parking for Patients at The Dominion Centre**

At the Dominion Centre there is a total of 15 disabled bays:

- There are 2 disabled bays in front of the building

- Featherstone Terrace car park has 7 disabled bays and around 50 parking bays which are charged at £1.20 per hour or £5.00 for the day.
- Next to Featherstone Terrance car park, on the right hand side, is the Local Authority car park; patients can use the 7 disabled bays only if required.
- There are two wheelchairs to assist patients who have difficulty walking to and from the car park, but patients may have to wait for these are in use.
