## We offer a range of different services that can be tailored to the needs of individual schools

The school partnerships and enrichment team has extensive experience of working with school leaders to creatively tackle barriers to learning faced by pupils outside of the classroom. We have a range of specific packages available for schools to purchase:

The above prices are for Ealing Learning Partnership (ELP) members. Non-ELP schools will be charged an additional 10%. The delivery of purchased packages is on academic basis. Details for each package are outlined below.

#### Bespoke consultancy package £1877

Four days of bespoke consultancy support delivered in school and tailored to the exact requirements of your school. Areas of work that we are able to cover include:

- Engaging parents in their child's learning and school life
- Enrichment activities for pupils and families
- Linking learning to future education and career choices
- Bespoke project development to tackle barriers to learning

A tailored programme of support will be designed following an initial planning meeting with a senior leader at the school.



#### Curriculum enrichment package £104

This package aims to support schools to harness the potential of free and low-cost opportunities, both in and out of school, to support the delivery of a wide-ranging curriculum through enrichment opportunities that extend beyond the academic, vocational or technical.

Schools can use the resources to broaden knowledge and awareness of opportunities that nurture and develop pupils' talents and interests.

The package includes:

- Termly Horizon bulletin: a roundup of free and low-cost opportunities for school resources, training, school visits and places of interest with free entry.
- Let's Get Out and About school holiday newsletter that includes free and lowcost activities to encourage families to visit places of interest and enjoy the wide range of activities on offer in libraries and museums, outdoor places to explore, rainy day activities for in the home
- Exclusive invitations to events and local opportunities as identified by the team and their networks.

#### Bespoke fundraising and grant writing £1877

If you are low on time and want hands on support to develop and prioritise projects, identify funders and make grant applications on your behalf.

This package includes four days of bid writing support.

In our experience, school-based projects focusing on the following groups and activities tend to be more successful at attracting external grants:

- Pupils with special educational needs and vulnerable pupils and families
- Environmental projects; outdoor learning
- Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) outreach
- ★ Arts and theatre educational trips
- ★ School holiday activities
- Projects that involve working in partnership with other schools

We have had significant success in securing money for Ealing schools – over a £1m since 2011! An Ealing school who has bought this support from the team for the last four years has secured over £80k in external funding.

### Engaging parents in early reading and phonics £1200

This package is for schools who want to improve the engagement of parents in supporting early reading and phonics at home, with a specific focus on targeted groups of parents whose children need extra support. The package includes:

- ★ Review school's current universal offer to parents/carers, how it supports reading at home and gives parents the skills to foster a love of reading, reinforce phonics knowledge and practice language comprehension
- ★ Work with school leaders to suggest improvements linked clearly to school reading priorities
- Design and delivery of 3 reading cafe sessions for targeted groups of parents based on the needs of the school, e.g. supporting phonics at home, developing inference skills, reading for pleasure etc
- ★ All resources and presentations provided to enable sessions to be repeated in future years by school staff.

#### Primary careers package £950

Employer Engagement at primary level gives all pupils the opportunity to meet positive rolemodels and have regular conversations that challenge stereotypes, raise aspirations and broaden horizons.

Evidence shows that positive impacts from career-related learning are greater when a consistent and whole school strategy is in place.

Career-related learning in primary schools is not about setting pupils down a specific path, but ensuring they understand that there are many options open to them.

To successfully develop a whole school approach, we work with you to review what is being done and advise and support you on how to fill in the gaps, closely aligned with your school priorities.

This would be a bespoke package with a clear focus on embedding and weaving career - related learning through the curriculum.

Some examples of ways we could support your school, depending on your priorities:

- Planning and delivery of a school employer engagement event in school with a range of local volunteers
- Signposting to activities and resources to challenge gender stereotypes about future careers and those which support pupils to develop employability and life skills to help prepare them for the next stage of their education
- ★ Providing your school with links with employers, a college or a university.
- Identifying and applying for funding to support raising aspirations themed events in school e.g. STEM event.
- Working with a local high school and their students to develop and maximise bespoke transition opportunities for KS2 pupils, these could be subject focused, supported by an employer, college or university
- Running a workshop for parents to raise awareness of the benefits of developing aspiration and employability skills in primary aged pupils using London labour market information followed up with pupil and parent careers related activities
- Support for staff and governors to link career related learning and cultural capital throughout the curriculum to enhance the experience and opportunities available to children, particularly the most disadvantaged.

#### Family school partnership award £500

Review your whole school approach to family engagement to bring about positive and effective change over the course of an academic year.

We support schools to gather stakeholder views, analyse the results, plan for change, and achieve recognition through the Family School Partnership Award.

Package includes:

- Access to online surveys for staff, governors and parents
- ★ Analysis of data by group and comparison with borough wide results
- Access to the EFSPA toolkit that includes practical resources, templates and advice for addressing areas for development
- Two planning and review workshops for staff leading the award
- Bespoke training courses on common areas for development, e.g. building positive relationships with parents.
- Awards ceremony for senior leaders and governors to recognise achievement
