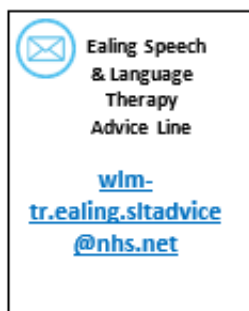
Welcome to our Summer 2025 training programme

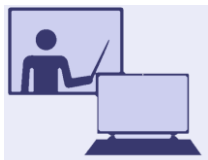
Ealing Speech and Language Therapists will run the virtual training sessions via Zoom. All sessions listed are free of charge.
