Our Impact Report 2020

92% of schools, colleges and community groups report increased **enjoyment, interest and engagement** in STEM subjects from young people engaging with STEM Ambassadors

Over 90% of event organisers (mostly teachers) report that STEM Ambassadors boost their **knowledge**, **confidence** and **enthusiasm** for STEM and their ability to bring it to life by linking lessons to **STEM careers and real-world context**

90% of STEM Ambassadors report **strong personal satisfaction** from their volunteering and the support it gives their local community
