

If there is a **child protection concern**

(e.g. child sexual exploitation; gangs, domestic violence, FGM etc...):

- Discuss concern with organisation's designated child protection lead and
- Refer to Ealing Children's Integrated Response Service (ECRIS) on: 0208 825 8000 option 2

Ealing 'Early Help Assessment Plan (EHAP)

Check with the Family Information Service (FIS) whether an EHAP is already in use, or how to initiate one by calling 020 8825 5588

If the child is a **looked after young person** (LAC), consult the LAC nurse on 0208 825 5103

Confidentiality

The age of consent for sex is 16yrs old. However, all young people have the right to confidentiality if there are no child protection issues and they meet the Fraser guidelines i.e.

- The young person understands the information being given to them
- The young person cannot be persuaded to inform their parent(s)/ carer(s)
- The young person is likely to continue to engage in sexual activity
- Their mental health will suffer as a result of not receiving the service
- It is in the best interest of the child to receive the service

The need to breach confidentiality should be carefully considered and discussed with the young person/s involved and your organisation's child protection lead.

Has the young person had unprotected sex?

NO but is likely to continue to engage in sexual behaviour
