- National Framework for Continuing Care (2016)

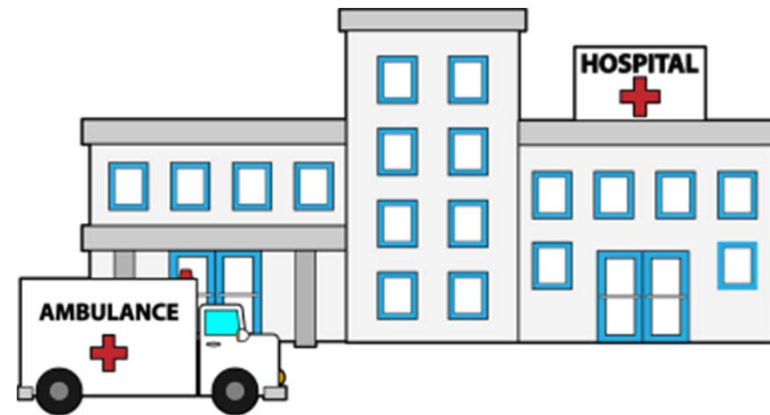

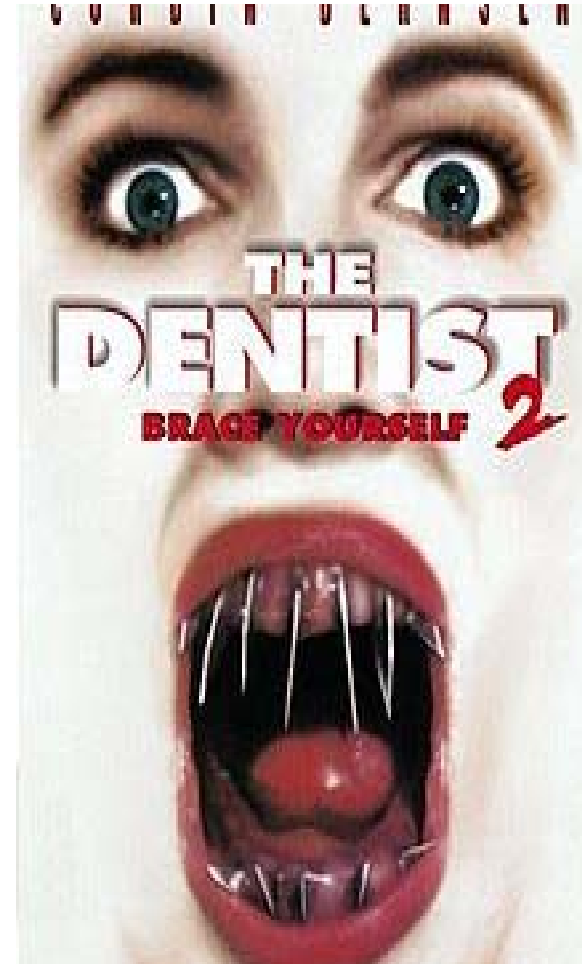

CCGs and the SEND Reforms

- DMO/DCO role
- Ensure services are mobilised to participate in the development of EHC plans.
- Arrangements for provision of medical advice including 19 – 25 yrs
- Agree and secure provision in Section G of EHC plans



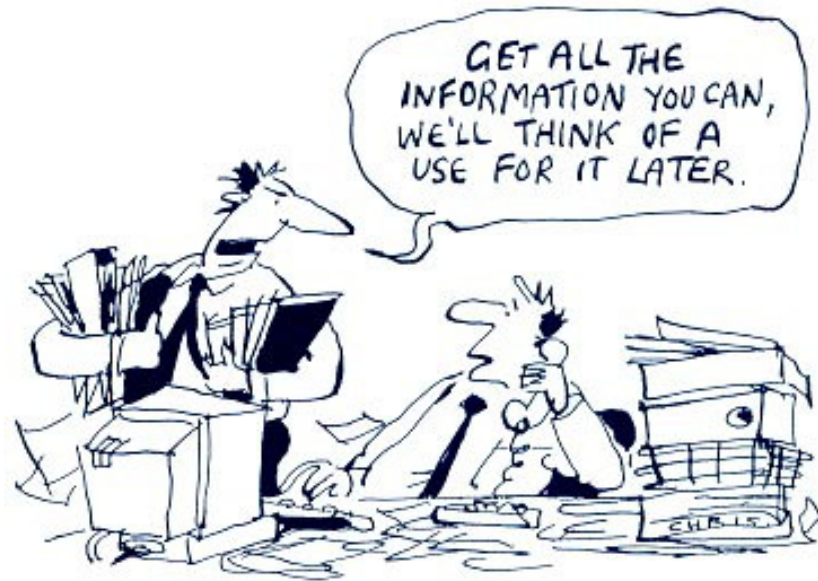
CCGs and the SEND Reforms

- Receive notification of requests for EHC needs assessments, decision to issue an EHCP and a copy of all EHCPs.
- Notify new CCG if responsibility changes.
- Personal health budgets
- Contribute to development and maintenance of Local Offer



CCGs and the SEND Reforms

- Local Area Inspection
 - DH Diagnostic tool
- Co-production
- Mediation and dispute resolution
- Commissioners of adult services
- Early identification and notification



Joint Commissioning Considerations

- MUST be joint commissioning arrangements in place between the LA and the CCG(s)
- Set out the education, health and care provision reasonably required by local children and YP; how this will be secured and by whom



Joint Commissioning Considerations

- Role of Health and Wellbeing Boards
- Shared or competing views re priorities?
- Joint commissioning teams / groups
- Aligned / pooled budgets
- Governance
