NPQML and NPQSL

New qualifications for leaders at various levels are available for 2018-19:

- National Professional Qualification for Middle Leaders (NPQML): if you are or aspire to become a middle leader with responsibility for leading a team
- National Professional Qualification for Senior Leaders (NPQSL): if you are or aspire to become a senior leader with cross-school responsibilities.

Two clusters are providing the programmes in Ealing:

- UCL cluster Ealing: Ealing Council, Ealing Teaching School Alliance (ETSA) and the Ealing Primary Teaching School Alliance (EPTSA)
- UCL cluster Montpelier Primary School: West London Teaching Alliance
