## **Willow Tree SSP Primary School Games core offer 2020-2021**

Following consultation with Sport England, the Youth Sport Trust and the Willow Tree SSP steering group we would like to share with schools the difference between the publically funded School Games offer and the additional SSP Bronze, Silver and Gold service levels to schools for 2020/2021.

Willow Tree Primary SSP receives £23,800 of national government funding to develop School Games across our 61 primary and secondary school (not infant schools). This funding is to cover provision for all schools. Due to additional costs incurred (e.g. additional staffing) primary competitions are more expensive to deliver than secondary competitions. Our current cost for our primary and special school competitions provision is more than the grant received.

This funding supports the salary for one person for three days, which includes the delivery of a School Games competitions calendar and supporting the further development of the Active 60 minute guidelines (including the Change4Life programme) and all aspects of the School Games Organiser (SGO) task list. Funding does not take into account other associated costs and therefore additional charges may be levied to cover these costs.

This funding in addition to minor charges incurred e.g. venue hire will provide schools with the following:

1. Access for **one school team** to attend the following:
  - Year 5/6 Tag Rugby competition
  - Year 3/4 girls Football festivals
  - Year 10 and under Volleyball competitions
  - Year 7 and 8 Sportshall Athletics competitions
  - Year 3/4 Keysteps Gymnastics competition
  - Inclusive Boccia competition and festival
  - Year 5/6 Quadkids Athletics competitions
  - Year 5/6 Tri-Golf competitions
  - Year 8 and 10 Handball competitions
  - Year 7/8 Inclusive Cricket competition
  - U13, U15 and U18 girls Rugby Union competitions
  - Year 7/8 boys Rugby League competition
  - KS3 and KS4 Dance
  - Year 7 boys and girls Hockey
  
2. Access for a school B team to attend the following development competitions:
  - Year 6 and under Boccia competition
  - Year 5/6 Quadkids Athletics competition
  - Year 3/4 Key steps Gymnastics competition



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3. Access for one team to attend the follow festivals:

- Year 1-3 Multi-skills competition
- Year 3/4 Change4Life festival

N.B. Changes to sports and activities offered may be made in line with the School Games strategy and SSP competition calendar.

The School Games offer provides competition access across 11 sports with a minimum of 32 events. To maintain the standards you have come to expect, including additional staff to ensure the high quality and safety of the event, the actual cost is more than the grant received. As a school not part of the partnership, you have the right to access the above national offer at point of access with a minor charging cost of £50 per team. For schools that have already committed to the partnership there will be no additional cost for team entry.

***Schools will be provided one credit which will provide free access to one competition/festival.***

The offer has been chosen to give a broad and balanced range of sports and activities which includes:

- Invasion games
- Net/Wall Games
- Striking/Fielding games
- Athletics
- Gymnastics
- A Paralympic sport
- Inclusive festivals
- Development competitions (not A team)
- Change 4 Life festivals
