

DSL guidance for pupils returning to high school

Overview of the advice, guidance, and support available if there is a safeguarding concern when pupils return to school.

With schools now open but with more pupils returning to school after a period of self-isolation you may see an increase in the number of safeguarding disclosures or concerns. For example, you may see or hear of criminal, violent or exploitative activity; notice a pupil is no longer coming to school; or think a pupil has become 'newly' vulnerable.

The referral procedure HAS NOT changed, and you should still go via ECIRS. However, for those cases where there is uncertainty, you want to talk through an incident, or you need guidance or advice please use the information below to guide and support your next steps. You may find it helpful to look at the Threshold of Need and Assessment Protocol document to support decision making and referral routes.
