

# Ealing Early Intervention Service (SAFE MHS)

Ealing Early Intervention Mental Health Service (SAFE MHS) is an emotional well-being service for families, delivered by Anna Freud in partnership with the London Borough of Ealing. The service offers support to children and young people from 0 to 18, and up to 25 for young people with special needs.

The service works with trusted adults close to a young person so that they can support the young person better, this includes parents, carers and professionals.

## We support young people and families through:

- Brief evidence-based interventions
- Individual and group parenting support programmes
- Parent webinars on common issues of need

- Individual consultations
