Attachment in the Classroom And the Impact of Aces (Adverse Childhood Experiences) – Three Part Training

Training Dates: 3rd, 10th & 24th May (Booking open NOW) 1st, 8th & 15th November 2023

- Feel more confident to identify an attachment need in a child
- Have a greater understanding of the behaviour of children with an insecure attachment
- Learn strategies to support children with an attachment need in the classroom
- Receive resources to support them to implement strategies back in school
- Understand how to put a Team Around the Child

Understanding Grief & Loss in Children

Training Date: 27th September 2023

- Aimed at Senior Leaders, Inclusion Leads or SENCOs

- Know how to implement a critical incident plan in school
- Feel more confident supporting children, parents and staff

Planning & Running a Bereavement Support Group for Children & Young People

Training Date: 4th October 2023

- For all staff working with children and young people
- This training provides all the resources to enable participants to run a bereavement programme that can be delivered to individual or groups of children/young people in school and includes:
- Processing the circumstances or event within the context of the child/young person's developmental ability
- Understanding the concepts of grief
- Identifying and Understanding Feelings and Behaviours associated with a normal grief response
- Identifying and practising healthy ways to cope
- Honouring the relationship and establishing continuing bonds
- Identifying and accessing their own support system

This course is £100 per person (£50 for any additional staff from the same setting). This cost includes a pack of resources so that the participant can go back into school and get started straight away with very little planning and preparation.

Planning & Delivering a Friendship Group

Training Date: 11th & 18th October 2023

- Receive all materials to plan and deliver 6-week Friendship Groups in their school
- Become familiar with the aims of the intervention and all the resources provided
- Feel confident to facilitate the intervention manage challenges that arise within the group
- Receive further support and guidance whilst running groups
