<b>HOLDING DIFFICULT CONVERSATIONS</b>	Designated Safeguarding Leads, Senior leaders, Heads of Year	<p>To support DSL's with holding conversations that may be difficult or uncomfortable, which may be needed as initial information gathering before deciding whether a safeguarding referral is needed.
