IDENTITY, ONLINE SAFETY AND EXTREMISM	Primary (Years 5 and 6)  Secondary (Year 7)	<p>This is a three-part series of workshops which aim to help build pupils' awareness and resilience against extremism and developed to fit with existing themes linked to Fundamental British Values, as well as wider curriculum subjects like RE, PSHE and Computing. The lesson topics are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identity and Community</li> <li>• Understanding Extremism</li> <li>• Online Resilience</li> </ul> <p>Once completed, staff can then come to a follow-up session, so that they can be confident to deliver the content to other year groups.</p>	3 x 1 hour session  (either one day or three separate sessions)	Ongoing
IDENTITY & EXTREMISM	Sixth Form (16+)	<p>An interactive workshop aiming to explore identity and what it means to individuals. The session aims to encourage students to critically think about identity and how feelings of a loss of identity can be exploited by extremists. By the end of the session students should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>identify what identity means to them</i></li> <li>• <i>understand how issues surrounding identity can be used to divide communities</i></li> <li>• <i>explore how individuals can be exploited because of their feelings/understanding of identity and community</i></li> <li>• <i>recognise how we can protect individuals from being exploited because of their feelings/understanding of identity and community</i></li> </ul>	1 x 2-hour workshop  (can be reduced/split if needed)	Ongoing
