



Stop, Look, Listen, Think

JTA 1: Hello, my name is (all JTAs say your names) and we are your JTAs. We are going to give you some tips today on crossing the road safely using 'Stop, Look, Listen, Think'.

JTA 2: It is important that we all be careful when walking to school and the 'Stop, Look, Listen, Think' method shows us how.

JTA 3: Firstly, you need to FIND A SAFE PLACE TO CROSS (Pause). It is always safer to use a pedestrian crossing but if there isn't one nearby, make sure to find somewhere safe to cross.

JTA 4: STOP (Pause) – when you approach a crossing, STOP before you come to an edge of the pavement

JTA 5: LOOK (Pause) – LOOK for cars, bikes, lorries and other vehicles, by looking right, left and right again. Remember, if vehicles are electric, you may not hear them, but you should be able to see them.

JTA 6: LISTEN (Pause) - LISTEN for vehicles too. You may be able to hear them before you see them

JTA 1: THINK (Pause) – THINK about whether there is enough time for you to cross the road safely.

ALL: Next time you cross the road, remember to say this to yourself so that you know what to do. So, once you have found a safe place to cross, what should you do? Everyone: (Pause) STOP, LOOK, LISTEN, THINK
